PVT, Co. E & M. Enlisted in Co. E on 9/9/1862 for 3 years at age 22. The Official Record spells his last name as Meschinot. Later he transferred to Co. M. Discharged 7/15/1865 with his company at Nashville, TN.

His post-war occupation was as a tailor in Dayton, KY. The 1890 Census of Union Veterans and Widows lists his address as PO Box 84, Dayton, KY.

The 1900 Census of Precinct A, Dayton, KY says he was born in Germany, immigrated to the US in 1850, and had been in the US 50 years. His wife was Anna and children were Mary, Barbara, and Peter J. at the time of the Census. Copy attached.

Pension Index Card shows his pension began on 3/26/1886 and wife Anna's began on 5/22/1906.

Mathias Maschinot was born January 1840 in Haspelschiedt, Departement de la Moselle, Lorraine, France, the son of Nicholas Petrus and Maria Maginot. He immigrated with his family arriving in 1850 to the United States. When the Civil War started he volunteered for the Union Army enlisting 9 Sep 1862 in the 4th Ohio Calvary, also known as the Cincinnati Union Dragoons.

Mathias' unit was organized August 5, 1861, for three years service, under Colonel John Kennett. In December joined General Mitchell in Kentucky. It led the advance on Nashville and the city was surrendered to Colonel Kennett by the Mayor. The Regiment pushed south with the army in the spring of 1862, and raided into Alabama, taking Decatur and Huntsville with many prisoners and supplies. It followed Bragg through Kentucky, and afterwards met with disaster, being surrounded by Morgan, losing over 200 men. It participated in the battles of Murfreesboro and Chickamauga, marched into East Tennessee and pursued Wheeler across the Tennessee River.

Mathias' regiment guarded railroads in Alabama until December 27, 1863, then re-enlisted as veterans, and in the spring of 1864 joined the 17th Corps in the Atlanta campaign. The Regiment raided in all directions about Atlanta, went with Stoneman south, and afterwards joined Kilpatrick. After the fall of Atlanta it proceeded to Nashville for re-equipment, taking part in the battle under under Thomas. It joined Wilson's raid to Selma, where the men dismounted and made a desperate charge over the works, carrying everything before them. In April it marched to Montgomery

and then to Macon. Here it remained on guard duty until May 23, 1865, when it moved to Nashville and was mustered out the latter part of July, 1865.

Mathias returned to Dayton Ky. where his brother John was living and then made his life in Kentucky. He married Anna Jennewein in 1866 in Cincinnati. By 1870 he was living in Dayton working as a tailor.

Nicholas Petrus Maginot (other spellings Maschino, Maschinot) born Apr. 19, 1793 in Lorraine, France to Johann George Maginot(Maschino/Maschinot) and Anna Maria (Diderich) Maginot. He married Regina 'Reine' Kilbertus on Nov. 6, 1818 in Haspelschiedt France. Reine died Aug. 16, 1841 in France. Nicholas emigrated to the U.S. in 1852. He died on May 13, 1886 and is buried at Four Corners, Spencer Township, Jennings County, IN.
